




This perception study aims to gauge people's opinions on air pollution and its detrimental effect on human life. The survey was conducted on a total of 2450 respondents from West Bengal (of which 920 respondents are from Kolkata) by SwitchON Foundation in 2023.


PEOPLE ASSOCIATING AIR POLLUTION WITH HEALTH THREAT



- Almost 80% of respondents in Kolkata and 72% of respondents in West Bengal associated air pollution with health threats.
- Rural dwellers partially relate health deterioration to air pollution while urbanizers say air pollution is causing serious damage to health.




REASONS OF AIR POLLUTION (PEOPLE'S PERCEPTION)



SOURCES OF AIR POLLUTION IN WEST BENGAL

- 90% of respondents from West Bengal, and 94% from Kolkata said vehicles, industries, and open waste burning are the major sources of air pollution.
- 25% of the respondents listed road dust to be another reason for air pollution.

- Most people reported to suffer from both higher and lower respiratory infections
- It is interesting to note, that people have also associated air pollution with lifestyle diseases (diabetes, hypertension), and also psychological symptoms (depression, and disturbed sleep).
