The Move for Earth Symposium in Akola laid the groundwork for a unified commitment to promote climate-resilient agriculture powered by decentralized renewable energy (DRE) for farmers. It convened a wide array of stakeholders, including government representatives, industry leaders, NGOs, farmers, rural women entrepreneurs, Farmer Producer Organizations, and Self Help Groups, fostering an inclusive and impactful dialogue. This event, held on February 26th at Sevarth FPC and Federation office in Akola, Maharashtra, was a collaboration between SwitchON Foundation and Clean Energy Access Network, Revitalizing Rainfed Area Network, Deutsche Gesellschaft fur Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ), DeveloPPP, Indo German Energy Forum, and Sustainable Womens Fed Farmer Producer Company Limited. Through workshops and panel discussions, the Symposium facilitated collaboration among diverse stakeholders to drive actionable solutions for promoting climate-resilient agriculture.
